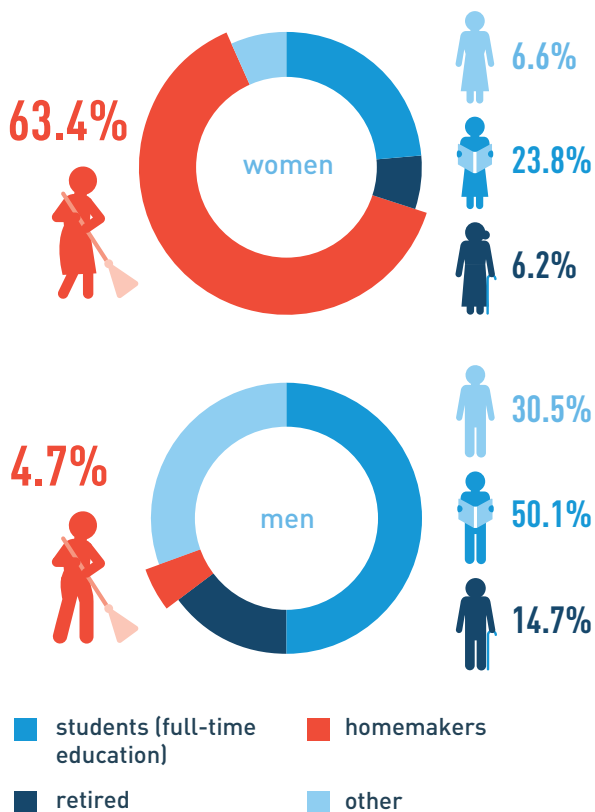
Unpaid care and domestic work: What is the situation in Kyrgyzstan?



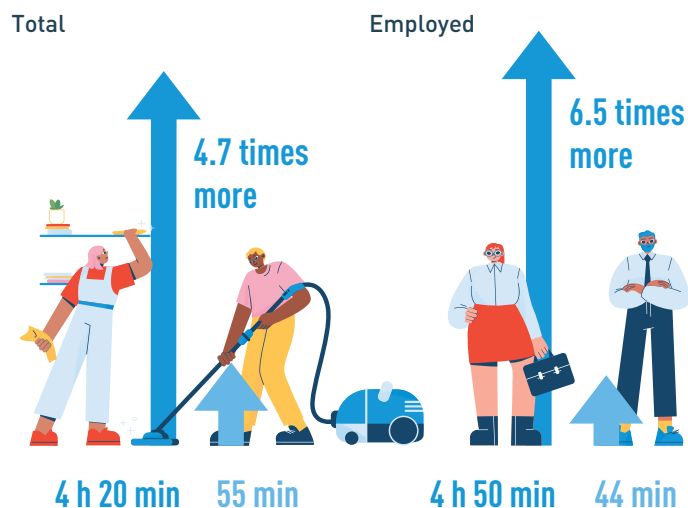
Women in Kyrgyzstan **spend almost 5 times more time** than men on unpaid domestic work, which hinders their participation in paid work.

63.4% of working-age women outside the labour force are not employed due to their domestic responsibilities

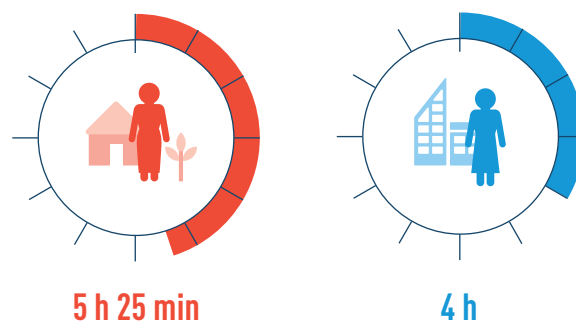
Distribution of working-age people outside of the labour force, by category



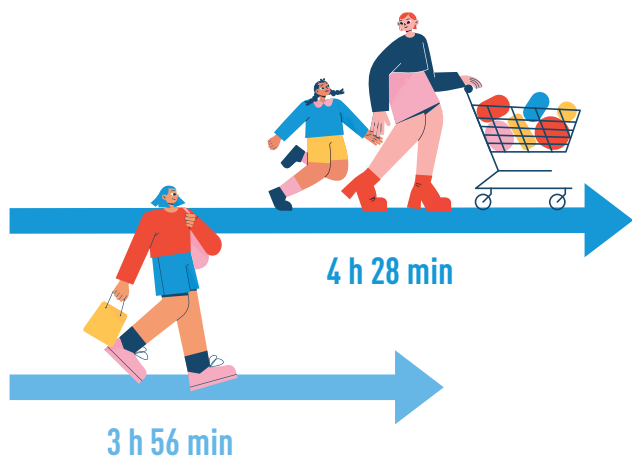
Women spend more time than men on unpaid care and domestic work



Working women in rural areas spend 1.3 times more time on domestic work than urban women

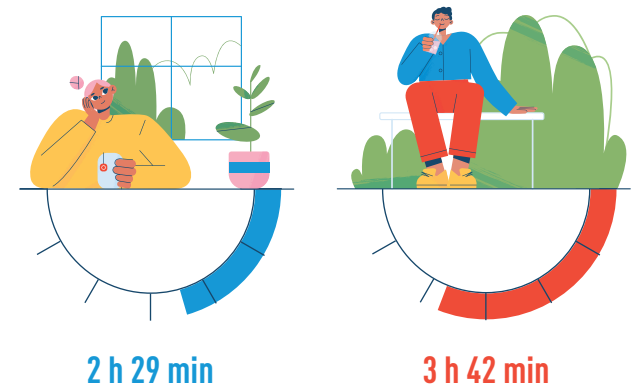


Women with children under age 16 spend 32 minutes more time than women with no children on domestic chores



Women have 1.4 times less free time than men

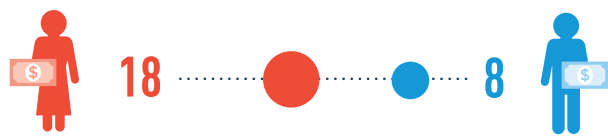
Amount of free time per day in a week



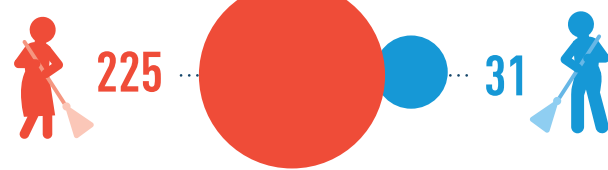
At home, men spend more time on repairs, while women spend more on cooking

Household chores performed by employed persons (in minutes per day)

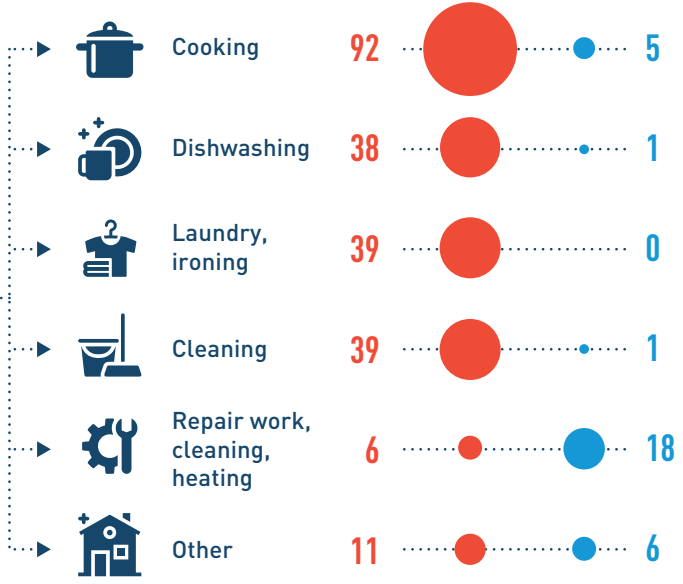
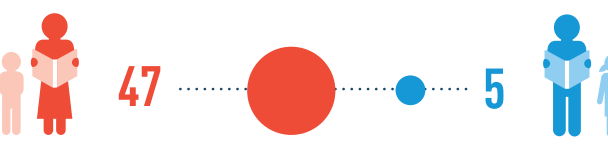
Purchase of goods and services
