## ORDER OF THE CABINET OF MINISTERS OF THE KYRGYZ REPUBLIC

Bishkek city, April 8, 2022, No. 183-r

To ensure the implementation of United Nations Security Council Resolution 1325:

- 1. Approve the Action Plan for the implementation of Resolution 1325 of the United Nations Security Council on the role of women in ensuring peace and security for 2022-2024 (hereinafter referred to as the Action Plan) in accordance with the annex
- 2. To ministries, state committee, administrative departments, local state administrations, local self-government bodies (as agreed):
- ensure the implementation of the Action Plan;
- based on the results of the half year, no later than the 15th day of the month following the reporting period, submit information on the implementation of the Action Plan to the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Kyrgyz Republic;
- to finance the activities of the Action Plan at the expense of funds provided for by the state administration and local self-government bodies involved in its implementation, approved by the budgets for the corresponding year, as well as other sources not prohibited by the legislation of the Kyrgyz Republic;
- take measures to implement the Action Plan with the participation of representatives of civil society, international and non-profit organizations.
- 1. The Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Kyrgyz Republic, following the results of each half-year, no later than the 25th day of the month following the reporting period, submit summary information to the Administration of the President of the Kyrgyz Republic.
- 2. Recognize as invalid the order of the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic dated September 21, 2018 No. 334-r.
- 3. To impose control over the execution of this order on the control over the execution of decisions of the President and the Cabinet of Ministers of the Administration of the President of the Kyrgyz Republic.
