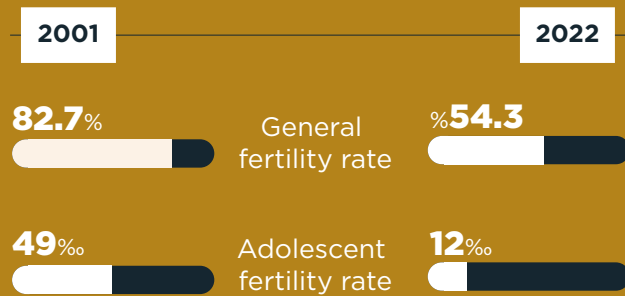

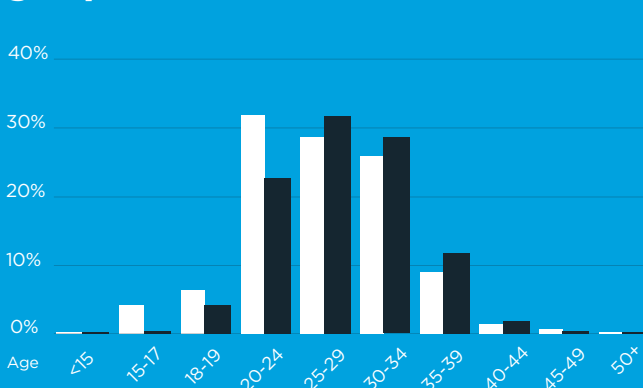
Life expectancy at birth, 2019 - 2021

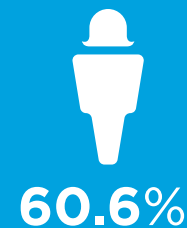


Percentage of birth by the age group of mother



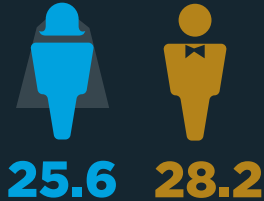
Contraceptive usage rate, TDHS, 2018

Proportion of women aged 20-24 years who were married or in a union before age 15 and before age 18, TDHS, 2018



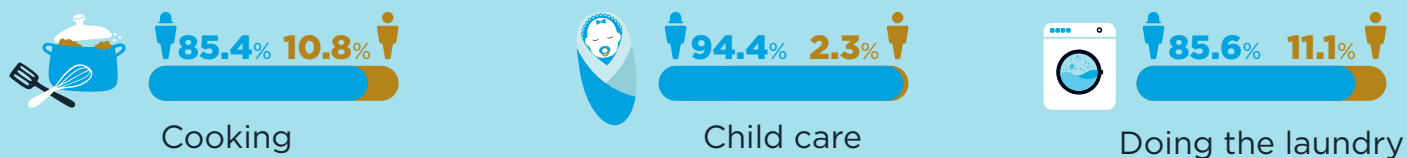

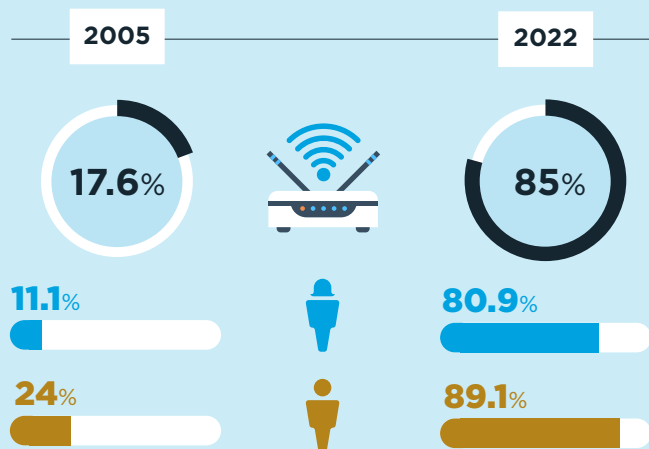
Average activity time per person for household and family care, 2014 – 2015



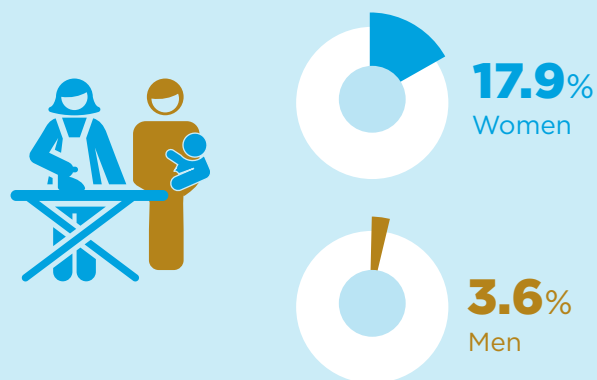
Individuals responsible for household chores, 2021



Rate of the internet usage of individuals aged 16-74 years old



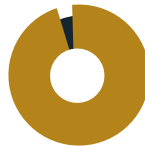
Rate of time spent on unpaid domestic and care work, 2015

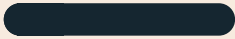

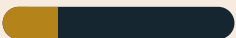

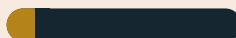

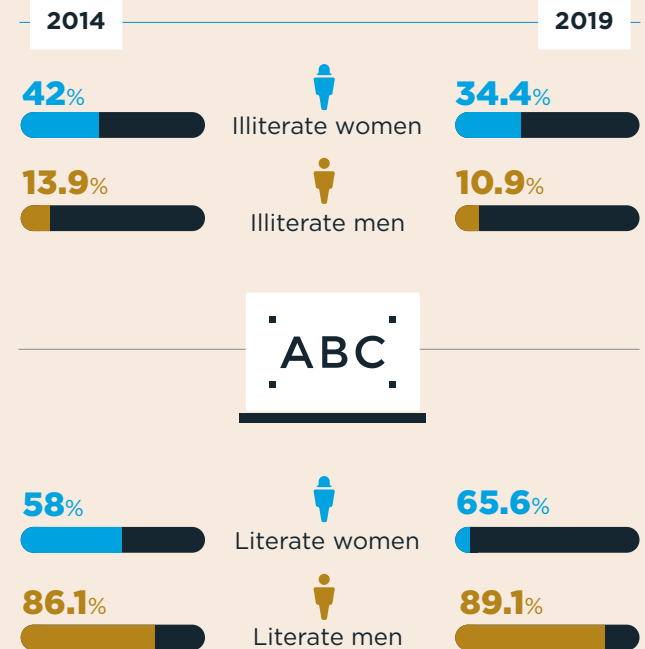

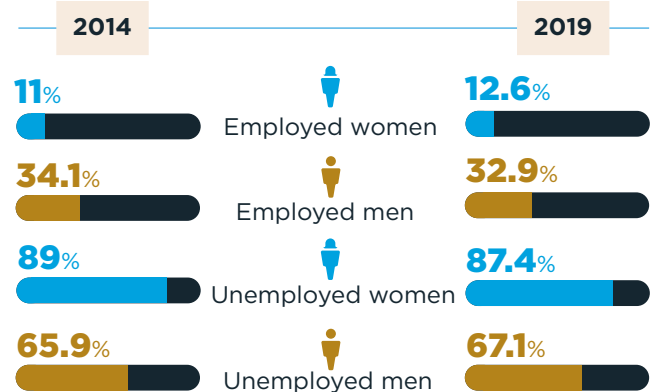
Educational status of individuals with disabilities



Literacy rate of individuals with disabilities

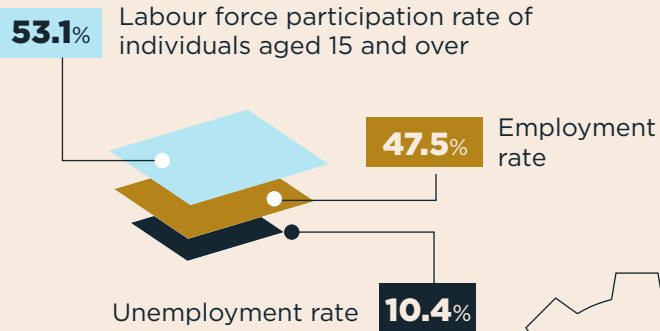


Employment status of individuals with disabilities

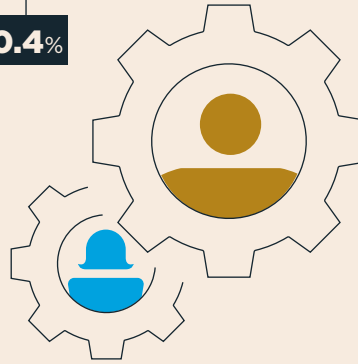
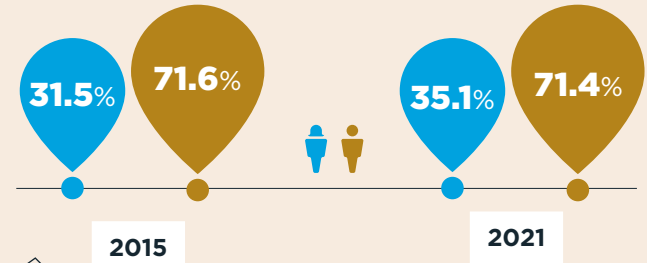

Labour force status of population, 2022



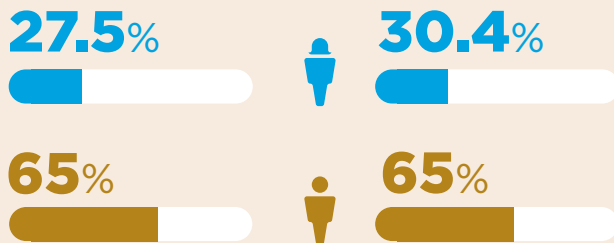
Labour force participation rate of individuals aged 15 and over, 2015 - 2022

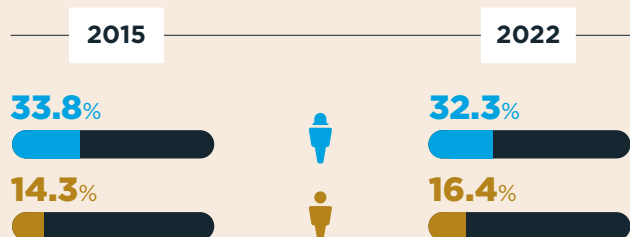

Gender pay gap by educational level, 2018

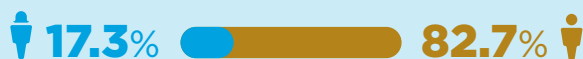

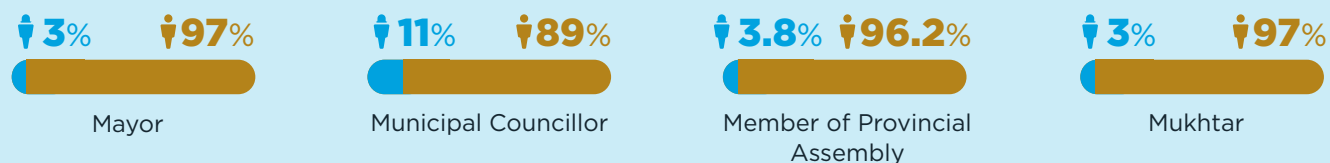
Rate of members of the parliament, 2022

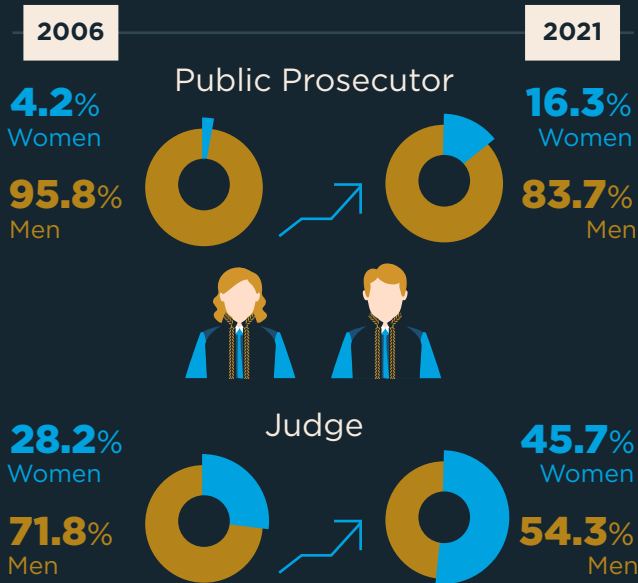


Rate of representation in local governments, 2019

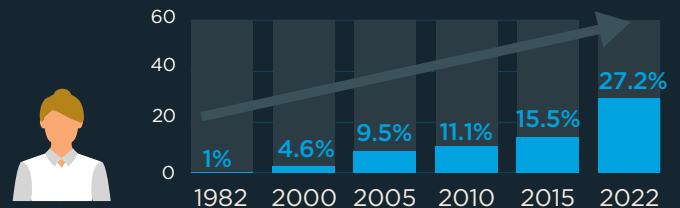

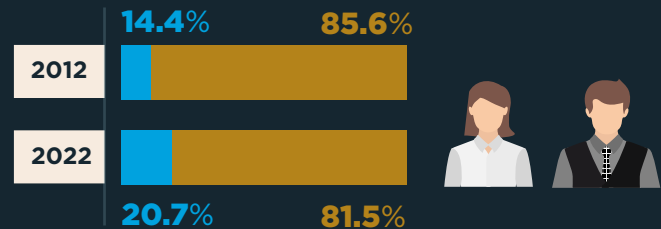
Rate of public prosecutors and judges by sex



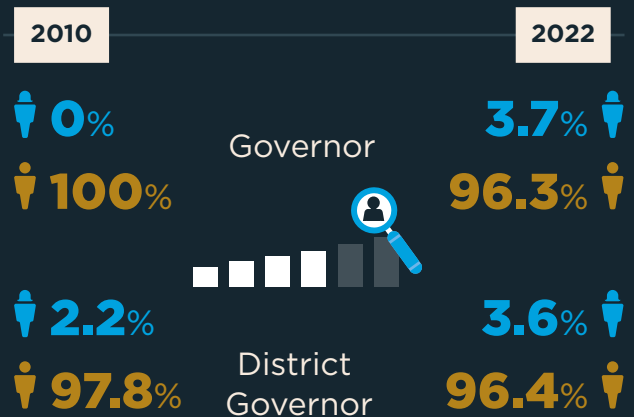

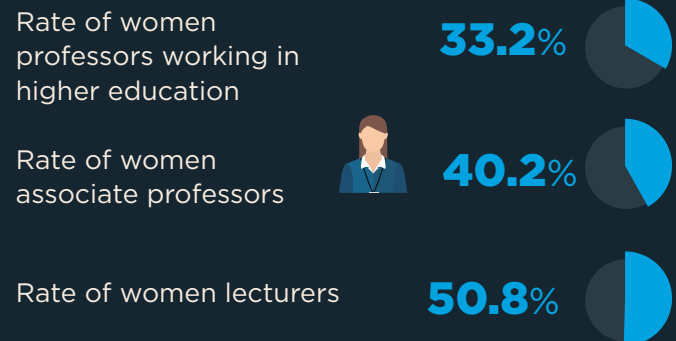


Rate of governor and district governor by sex

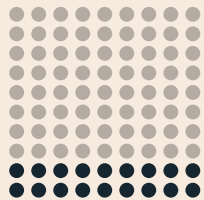

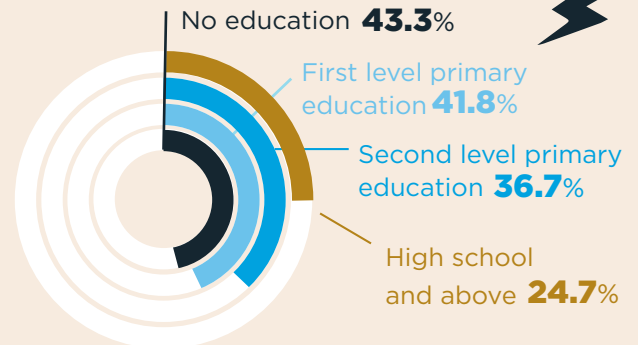


Rate of feeling unsafe of individuals when they are walking alone at night in their neighborhood, 2022

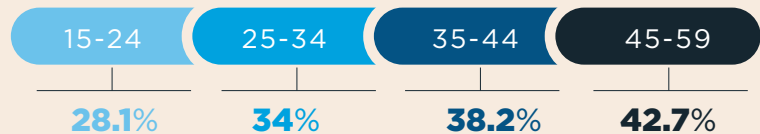

Rate of physical and/or sexual violence in lifetime by educational level, 2014

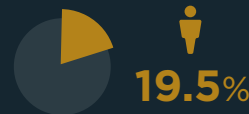
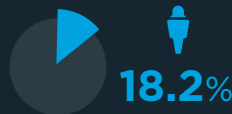


Rate of physical and/or sexual violence in lifetime by age groups of women, 2014
