Background: In 2025, the global community will mark the thirtieth anniversary of the <u>Fourth World Conference on Women and the adoption of the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action</u> (1995), and 10 years of the <u>2030 Agenda</u> and <u>the Sustainable Development Goals</u>.

This milestone prompts a critical review of state actions and compliance with the platform's objectives, a process commencing with the national reviews in 2023 and culminating in a global assessment at the 69th session of the Commission on the Status of Women in March 2025.

The Beijing+30 review process will involve among others stakeholders from the government, the private sector, civil society organizations (CSOs), and youth, facilitating dialogue and collaboration to elevate local realities onto the global stage.

The UN Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) and UN Women Europe and Central Asia Regional Office (ECARO) will jointly organize the Regional Review Meeting on the 30-year review of the Beijing Declaration and Platform for Action in the UNECE region and its alignment with the 2030 Agenda in Geneva on 21-22 October 2024.

In the lead-up to the UNECE Regional Review Meeting, taking place on 21-22 October 2024, and the Global Review in March 2025, UN Women Europe and Central Asia Regional Office and the Beijing +30 Civil Society Steering Committee are organizing a series of consultations for civil society, to prepare for and inform the Beijing+30 review process and key milestones.
