Population and Fertility

Definitions

Adolescent fertility rate: The average number of live births per thousand women in 15-19 age group.

Age specific fertility rate: The average number of live births per certain age group of a woman.

General fertility rate: The number of births per 1000 females in 15-44 age group in a given year.

Live birth: Regardless of the duration of pregnancy, the births where the child lives at least a few minutes and shows evidence of life like crying, breathing or moving.

Total fertility rate: The average number of live births that a woman would have under the assumption that she survived to the end of her reproductive life (15 to 49 years of age) and bore according to a given age specific fertility rate.

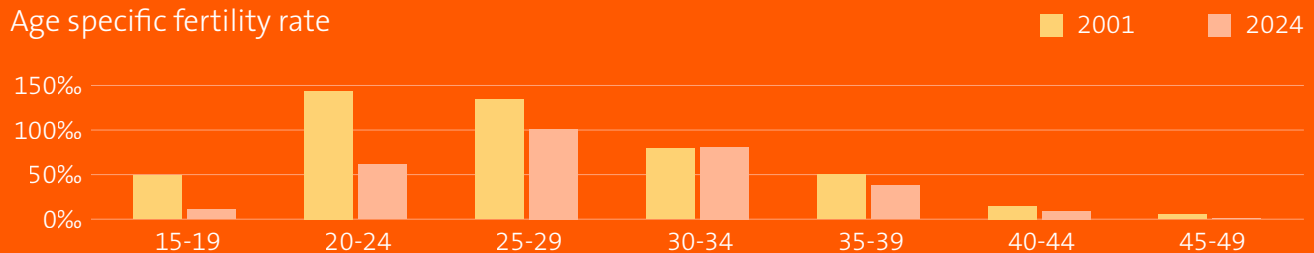

Health

Definitions

Antenatal care coverage: It is the percentage of women aged 15-49 with a live birth in a given time period that received antenatal care provided by a skilled health personnel (generally doctors nurses or midwives) at least once during pregnancy.

Healthy Life Years: It is defined as the number of years of life at a certain age without serious or moderate health problems.

Life Expectancy at birth: It is the average number of years a newborn is expected to live having been exposed to age specific mortality rates at certain periods through his/her life.

Maternal Mortality Ratio: It is obtained by multiplying 100.000 with the proportion of the number of mothers who die due to pregnancy in one year to the number of live born babies in the same society by the same year.

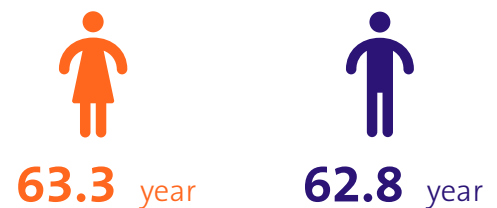

Disability

Definitions

Individuals with hearing problems: Includes those who, despite using assistive devices, have great difficulty hearing or cannot hear at all.

Individuals with learning and memory difficulties: Includes those who have great difficulty or are completely unable to learn new things/acquire new skills, remember, or concentrate.

Individuals with stair-climbing difficulties: Includes those who have great difficulty going up or down stairs or cannot do so at all.

Individuals with vision problems: Includes those who, despite using assistive devices, have great difficulty seeing or cannot see at all.

Individuals with walking difficulties: Includes those who, without using assistive devices (e.g., a cane), have great difficulty walking 500 meters or cannot walk at all.

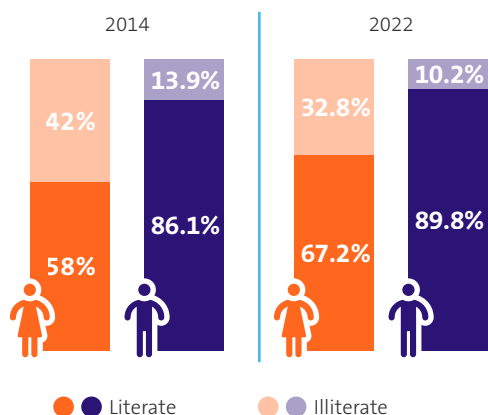

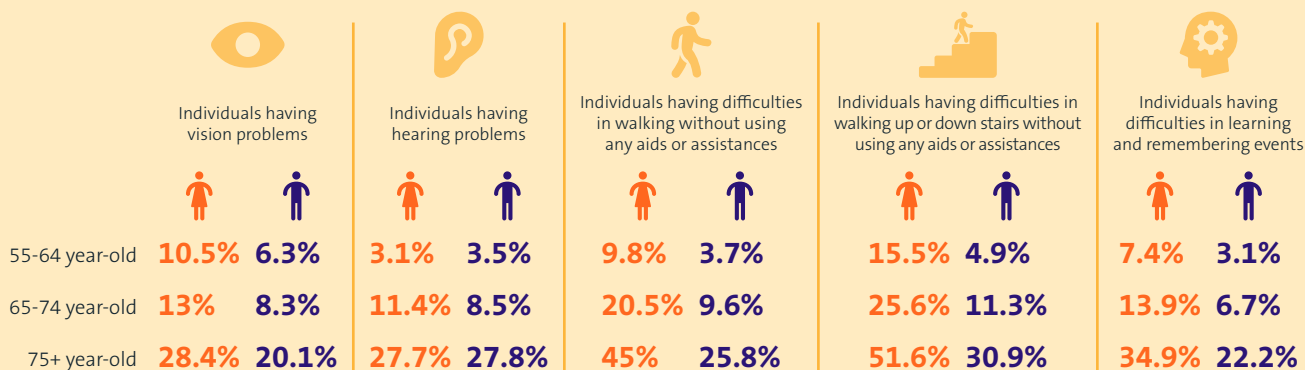

Education

Definitions

Graduates in the fields of education, health and welfare, humanities and art at the tertiary level: It is produced from the number of graduates under the titles of “Education”, “Health and Welfare” and “Arts and Humanities” in the classification of fields of education and training, which is the content of higher education statistics.

Graduates in the fields of science, technology, engineering and mathematics at the tertiary level: It is produced from the number of graduates under the titles of "Information and Communication Technologies", "Natural Sciences, Mathematics and Statistics" and "Engineering, Manufacturing and Construction" in the classification of fields of education and training, which is the content of higher education statistics.

Gross enrolment rate: It is obtained by dividing the number of students enrolled in a specific level of education by the population in that level’s theoretical age group.

Illiterate population: The person who was absent from school or who know how to illiterate.

Mean years of schooling: Mean years of schooling is average number of completed years of education of a country’s population aged 25 years and older, excluding years spent repeating individual grades.

Net enrollment rate: It is obtained by dividing the number of students of a theoretical age group enrolled in a specific level of education by the population in that age group.

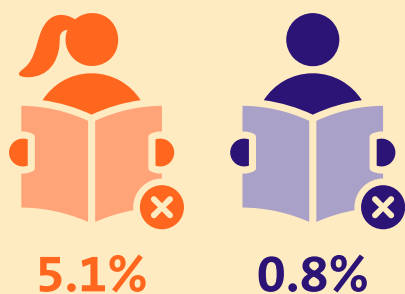

Proportion of individuals aged 25 and over who have completed at least one level of education, 2024

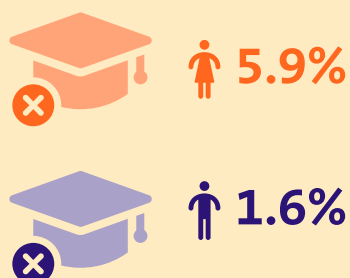


Distribution of the population 25 years of age and over by the level of education completed, 2024

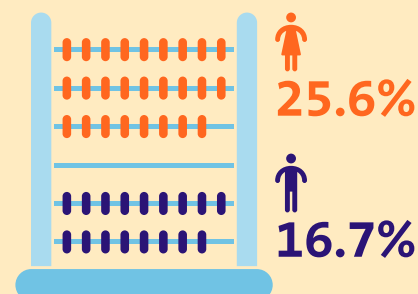

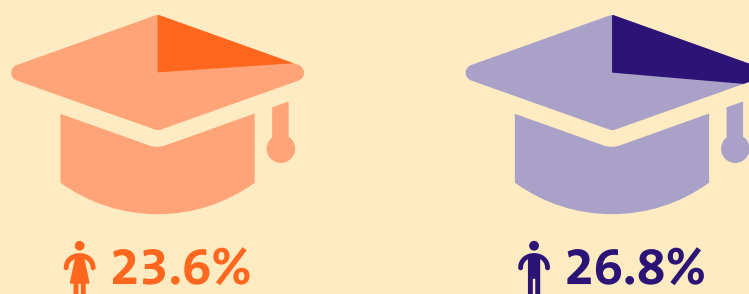

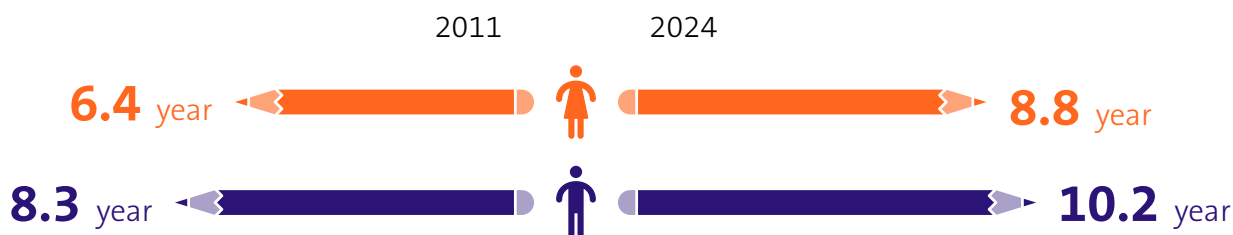

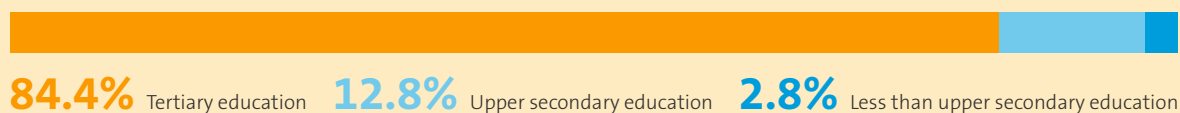

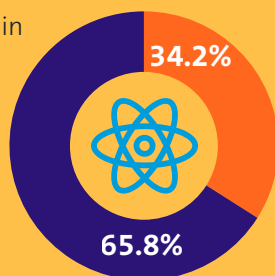

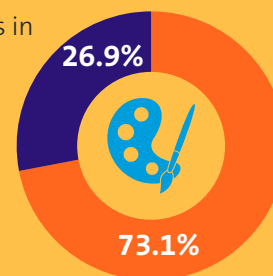
The highest level of education completed by individuals whose mother are higher education graduates (25+), 2024



Proportion of graduates in the fields of science, technology, engineering and mathematics at the tertiary level, 2023-2024

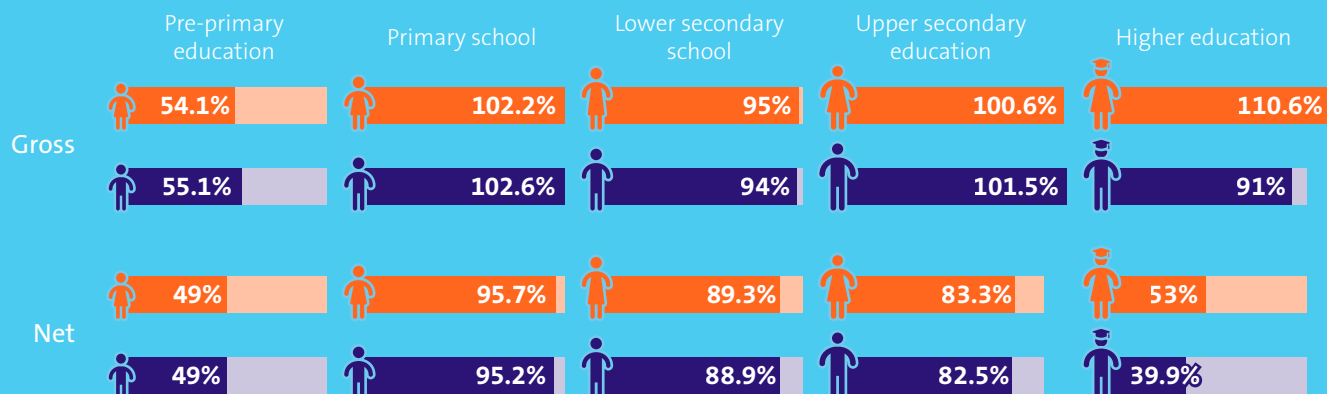


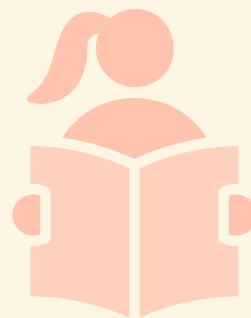
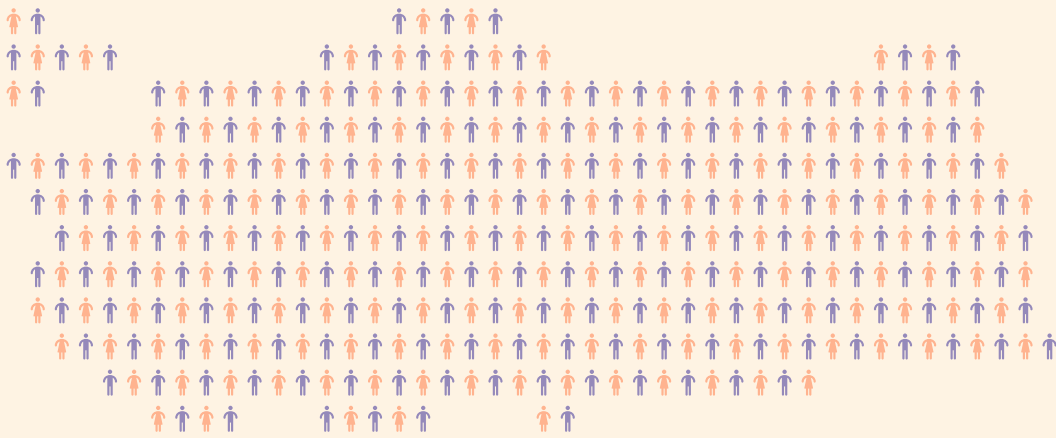
Proportion of graduates in the fields of education, health and welfare, humanities and art at the tertiary level, 2023-2024

Labour Force and Employment

Definitions

Duration of working life: The indicator measures the number of years a person aged 15 and over is expected to be active in the labour market during his or her lifetime.

Employment rate: Employment rate is the ratio of employed persons to the non-institutional working age population.

Gender pay gap: Percentage of the difference between all men's gross wages/salaries and all women's gross wages/salaries working in listed classifications (such as education, occupation etc.) over all men's gross wages/salaries in the reference period.

Labour force participation rate: Indicates the ratio of the labour force to non-institutional working age population.

Neither in employment nor education and training (NEET) rate: It is the ratio of young population that are neither in employment nor education and training to the total young population.

Unemployment rate: Is the ratio of unemployed persons to the labour force.

Unregistered employment: Persons who are not registered to any social security institution due to main job worked in reference week.

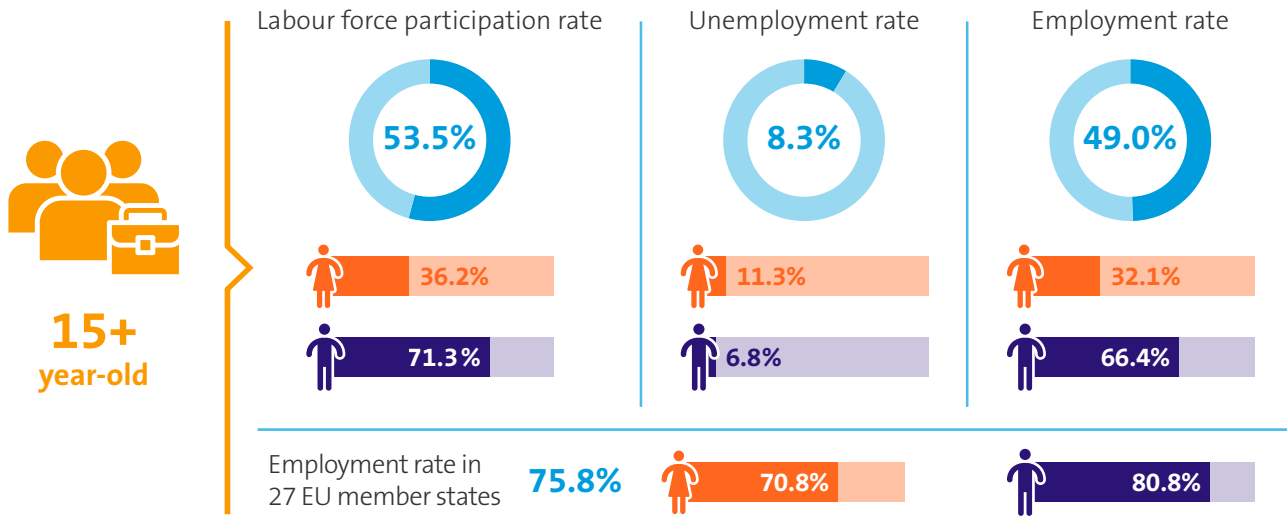

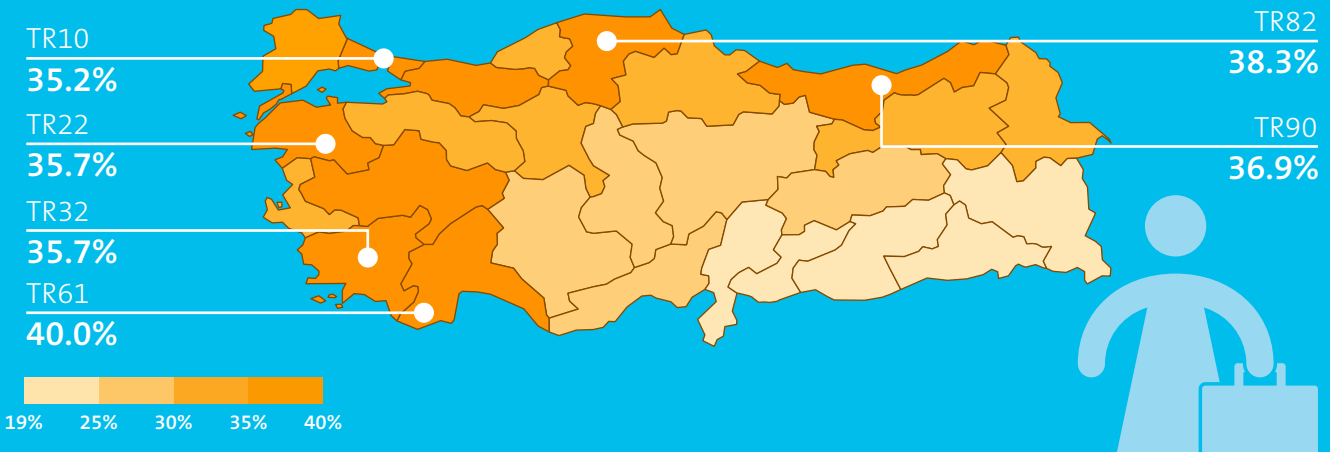

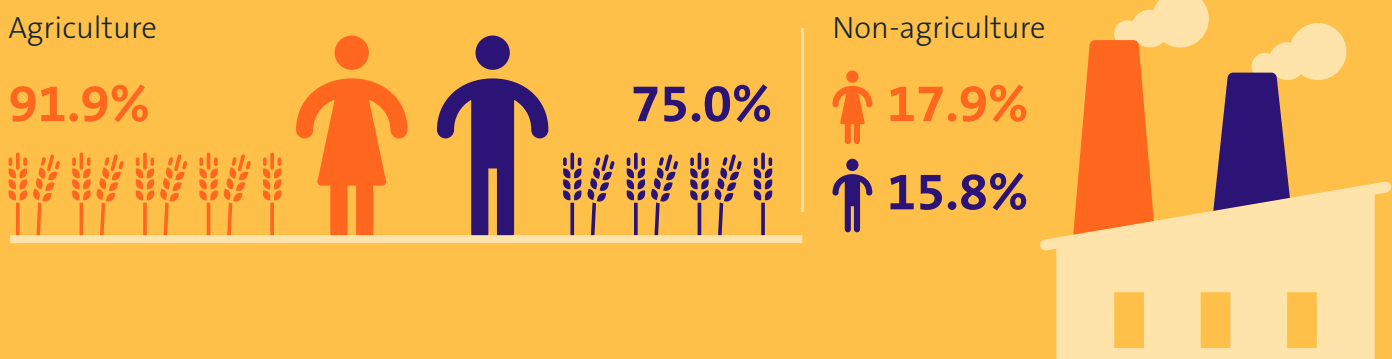
LABOUR FORCE STATUS OF POPULATION, 2025



Women's employment rate by the classification of Statistical Region, SR Level 2 (26 Region) (15+), 2025

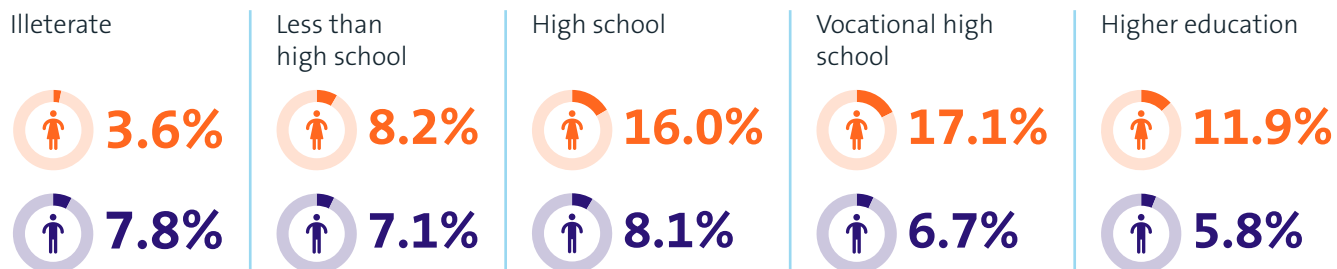


Informal employment as a percentage of agriculture and non-agricultural employment (15+), 2025

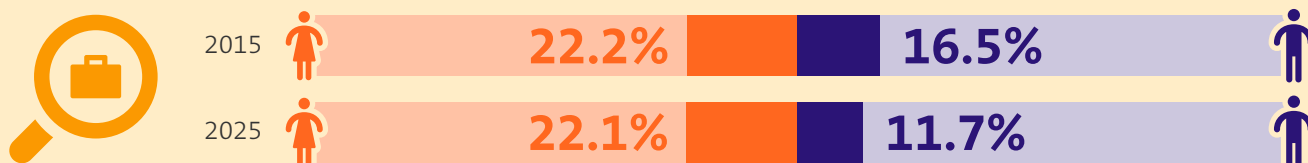

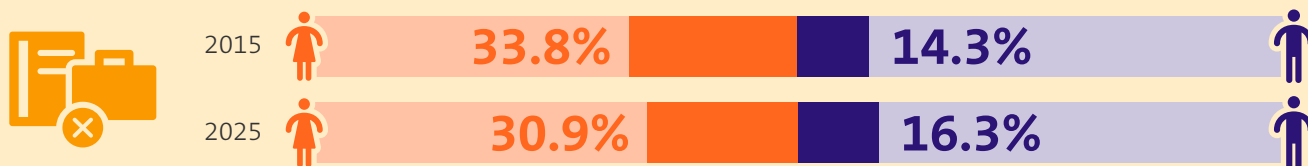
Unemployment rates level of education (15+), 2025



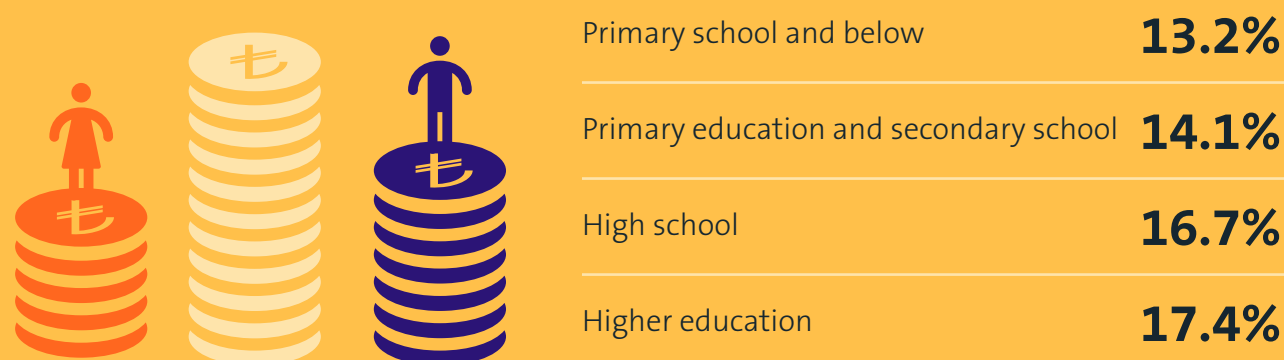
Youth unemployment rate for ages 15-24

Gender pay gap by level of education, 2023

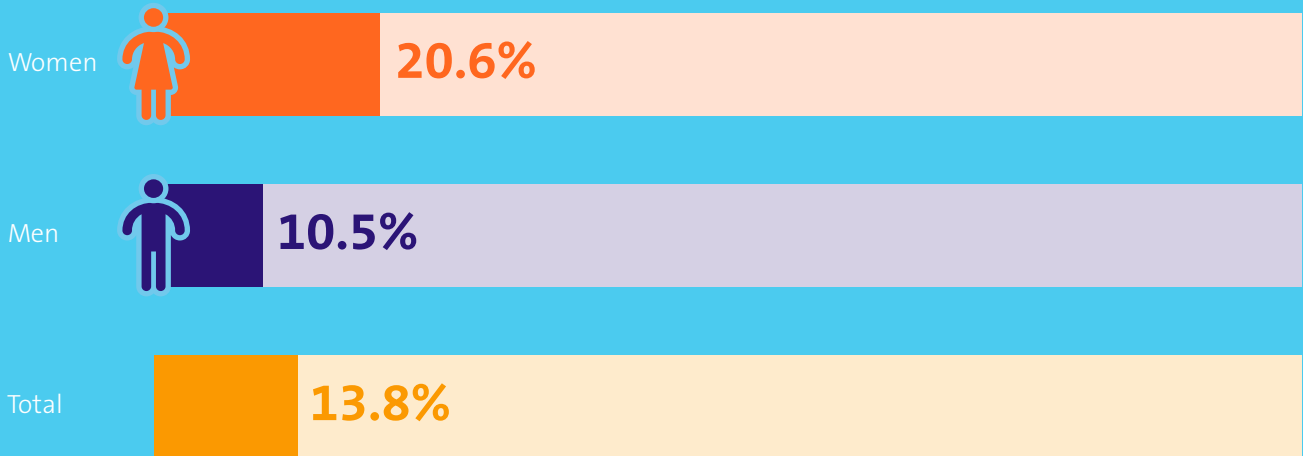

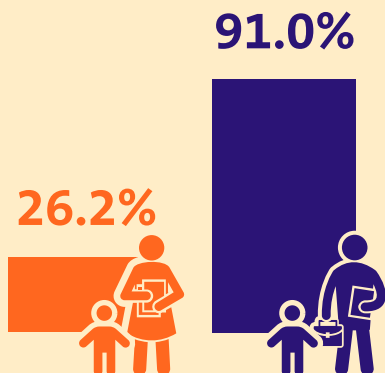

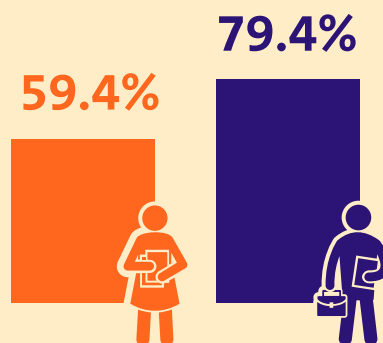
Part time employment rate (% of total employment) (15+), 2025



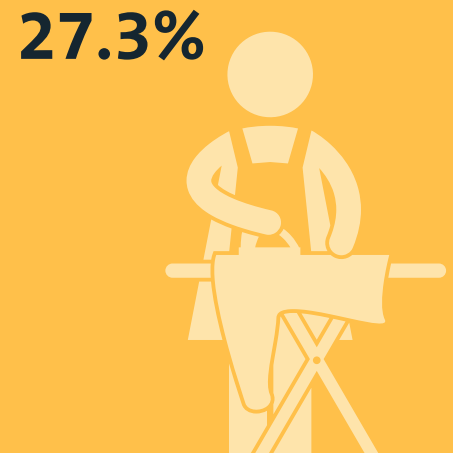
Employment rate of individuals aged 25-49 with children below 3 years old in the household, 2025

Participation in Decision-Making Mechanism

Definitions

Deputies: The number of representatives has been increased to 550 from 450 in 1995 by changing the article 3 of the Law No. 2839 on General Election with the article 8 of the Law No. 4125 and the number of representatives has been increased to 600 from 550 in 2017 by changing the Constitutional amendment.

Individuals in senior and middle management positions: This indicator refers to the proportion of females to the total number of persons employed in senior and middle management. Sub-groups “11- Presidents, senior executives and legislators”, “12- Commercial and administrative managers” and “13- Production and specialized service managers” are covered under the main group 1 of the International Standard Classification of Occupation (ISCO-08). Sub-group 14 (hospitality, retail and other services managers) is excluded from the main group 1 since these sub-groups comprise mainly managers of small enterprises.

Local governments: It refers to constitutional organizations established in order to meet the common and local needs of people living in communities of different sizes within national borders and within the legal order.

Mayor: A mayor is the highest ranking officer in the municipal government of town or a large urban city.

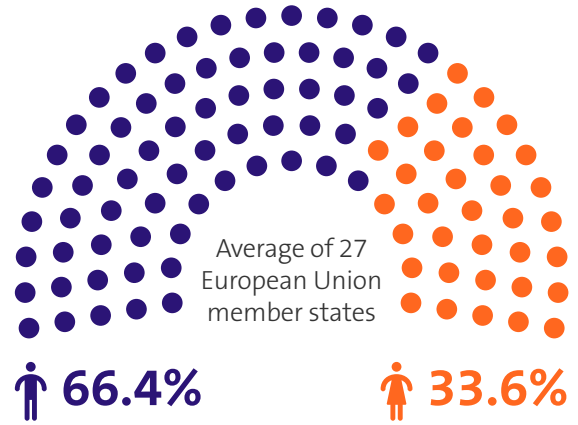
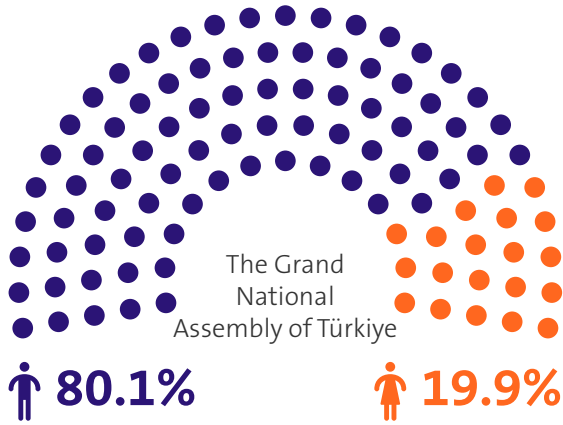

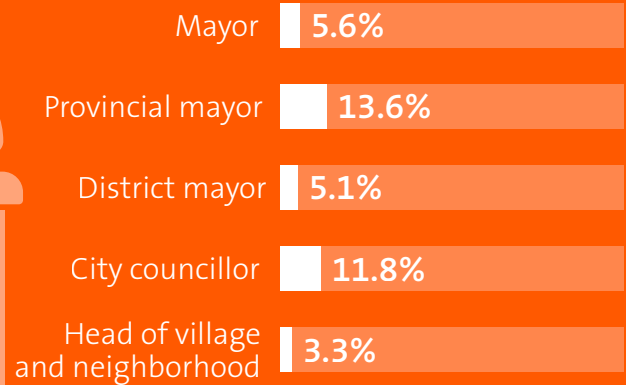
PROPORTION OF MEMBERS OF THE PARLIAMENT, 2025



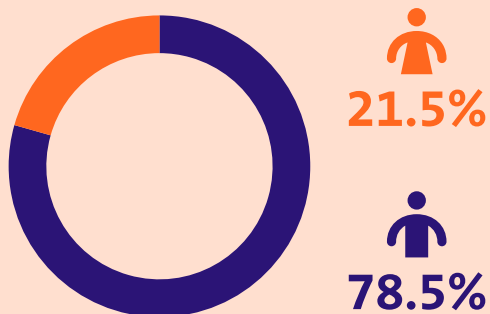
NUMBER OF MINISTERS, 2025

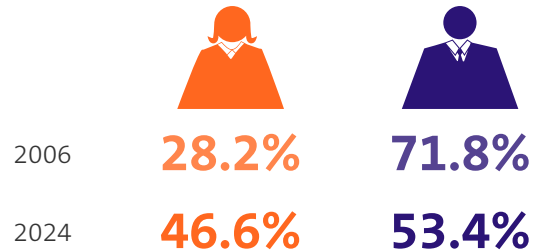

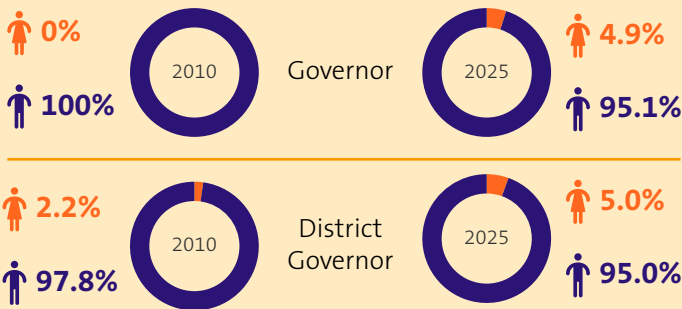

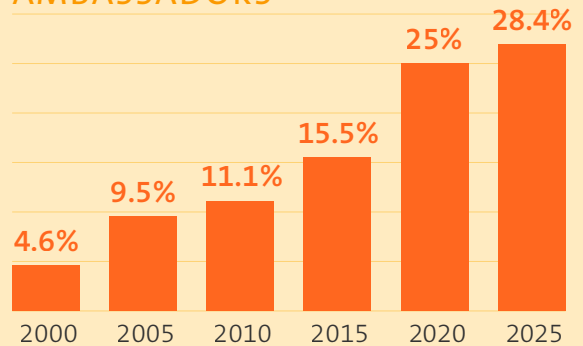

PROPORTION OF GOVERNORS AND DISTRICT GOVERNORS

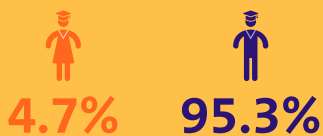


PROPORTION OF WOMEN AMBASSADORS

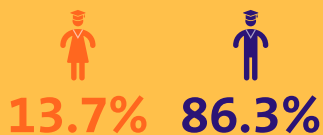


PROPORTIONS OF RECTORS AND ACADEMICS IN HIGHER EDUCATION

Marriage

Definitions

Child marriage: It refers to both formal and informal unions in which at least one of the parties is under the age of 18.

Marriage: In accordance with the Turkish Civil Code, is a contract made between a man and woman to live together, sanctioned by a legal authority.

Mean age at first marriage: It is the mean age of men and women when they get married for the first time in a given year.

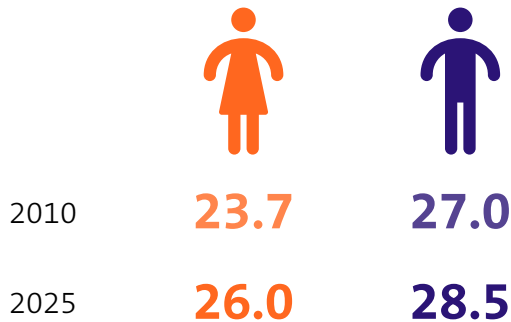

MEAN AGE AT FIRST MARRIAGE

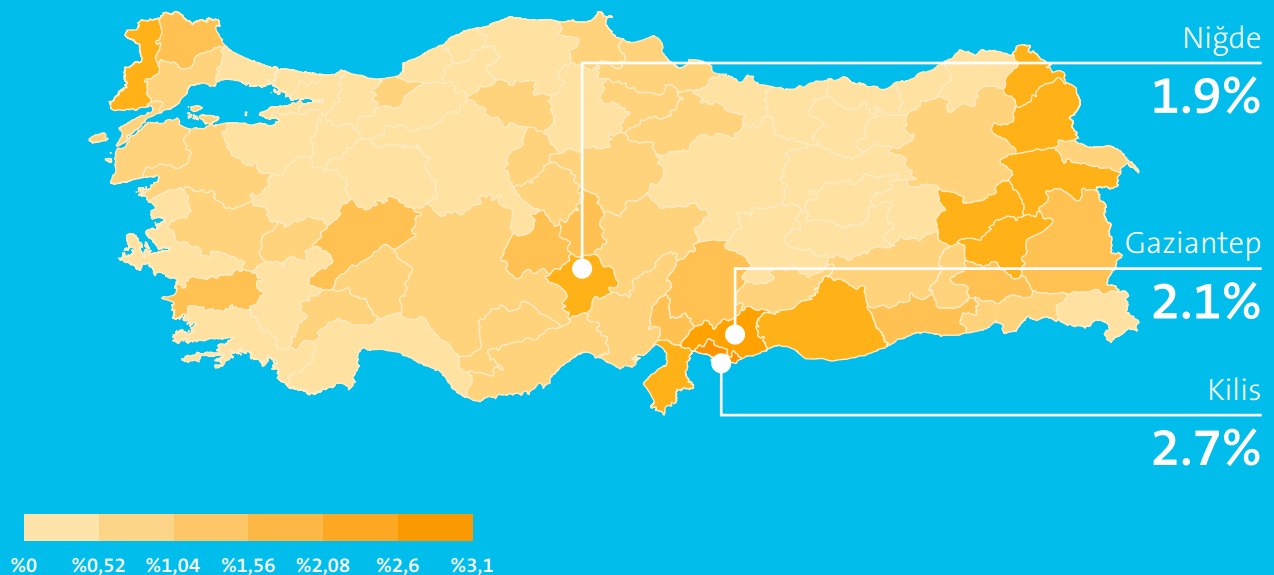


Proportion of individuals who experienced arranged marriages with the decision of their family without taking their opinion, 2021

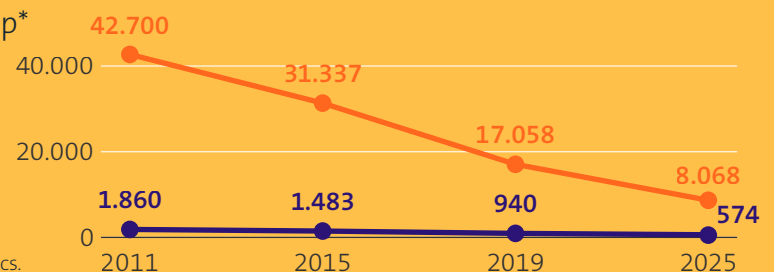
Proportion of girls who got married in the 16-17 age group to the girl child population in the same age group by province and the highest 3 provinces, 2025*

Family Life

Definitions

Average activity time: Average value in 24 hours of total time spent by individuals aged 15 and above for any activity. This period is average taken over all people and all year (work days and weekends as well as period of the holiday).

Individuals usually responsible for household chores: Individuals responsible for household chores are classified as either non-household members or household members. This indicator represents the gender ratio among those who are household members.

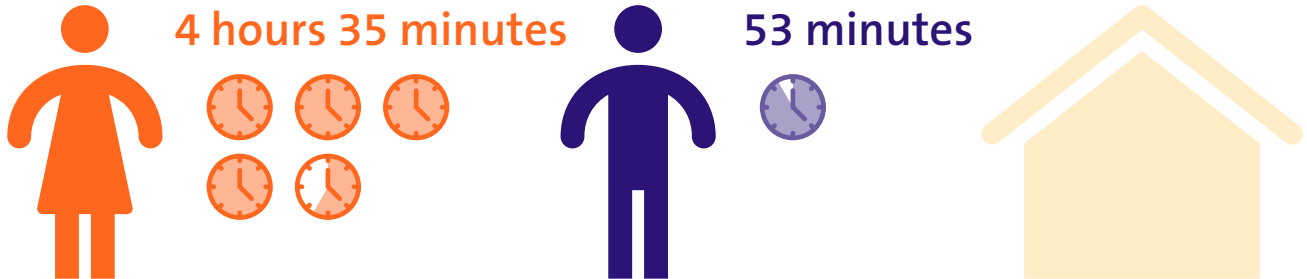

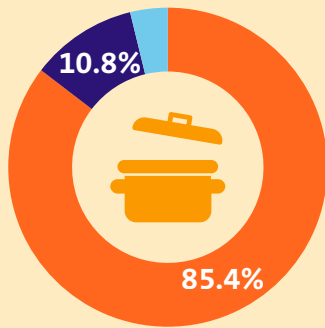

AVERAGE ACTIVITY TIME PER PERSON FOR HOUSEHOLD AND FAMILY CARE, 2014-2015

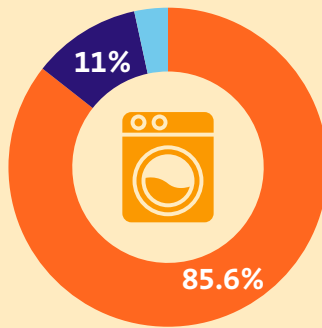


PROPORTION OF WOMEN AND MEN TAKING RESPONSIBILITY FOR HOUSEHOLD CHORES, 2021

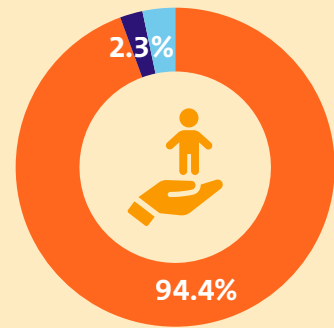

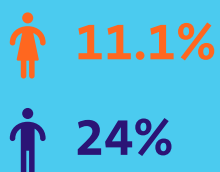

Proportion of time spent on unpaid housework and caregiving to total time, 2014-2015

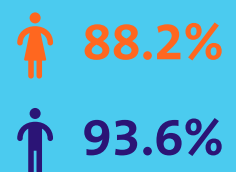


PROPORTION OF THE INTERNET USAGE (AGE GROUP OF 16-74)

Violence and Safety

Definitions*

Digital violence: Try to communicate with or follow the person via internet or social media tools such as Facebook, X (Twitter), Instagram, even if the woman does not want to.

- Insulting or swearing at a person on the internet or social media, or engaging in insulting or humiliating words and behavior
- Sending unsolicited sexually explicit written, audio or video messages via the internet or social media
- Getting hold of a woman's private information (phone, address, ID number) via the internet or social media
- Sharing the woman's private information (phone, address, identification number) on the internet or social media to cause third parties to disturb the woman
- Threatening to share sexually explicit/private images of a woman on the internet or social media
- Sharing sexually explicit/private images of a woman on the internet or social media
- Creating fake accounts in the woman's name on social media and making posts from these accounts without the woman's consent

Economic violence: Preventing her from working even if she wants to work or causing her to leave a job, Preventing her from attending school even if she wants to study or causing her to leave school, Take away person's income, money or property even if the person does not want to, Although she/he has money for other expenses, she/he does not meet the needs of the house (food, clothing, bills, etc.) and leave her in a difficult situation.

Emotional violence: Upset by insulting or swearing, Belittling or humiliation in front of others, Threaten to harm her or relatives, Banning/preventing contact with her family or close relatives, Always wanting to know where she is, constantly checking and trying to keep under pressure, Blame spouse of cheating, accuse.

Physical violence: Pushing, punching or pulling hair, Slap or threw something that could hurt, Hit with a fist or something else that could hurt, Kicking or dragging, Squeeze throat or burn some part of body, Attack using tools such as knives, guns.

Sexual violence: Touching for unwanted sexual purposes or engaging in sexual behavior, Forcing to perform an unwanted and uncomfortable sexual act (except sexual intercourse) by threatening or using physical force, Ask to perform sexual acts against her will in order to get hired, protect job, or get promoted, Ask to perform sexual acts against her will in order to pass an exam or get a good grade, Engage in forced sexual intercourse using physical force even if it is not desired, Have sexual intercourse even if it is unwanted because she is afraid of what someone will do.

Stalking: All repetitive, intentional and threatening behaviors by recognized or unrecognized people that cause a person to fear for their own safety are defined as persistent stalking. In this survey, information about persistent stalking was obtained through questions related to persistent stalking behaviors.

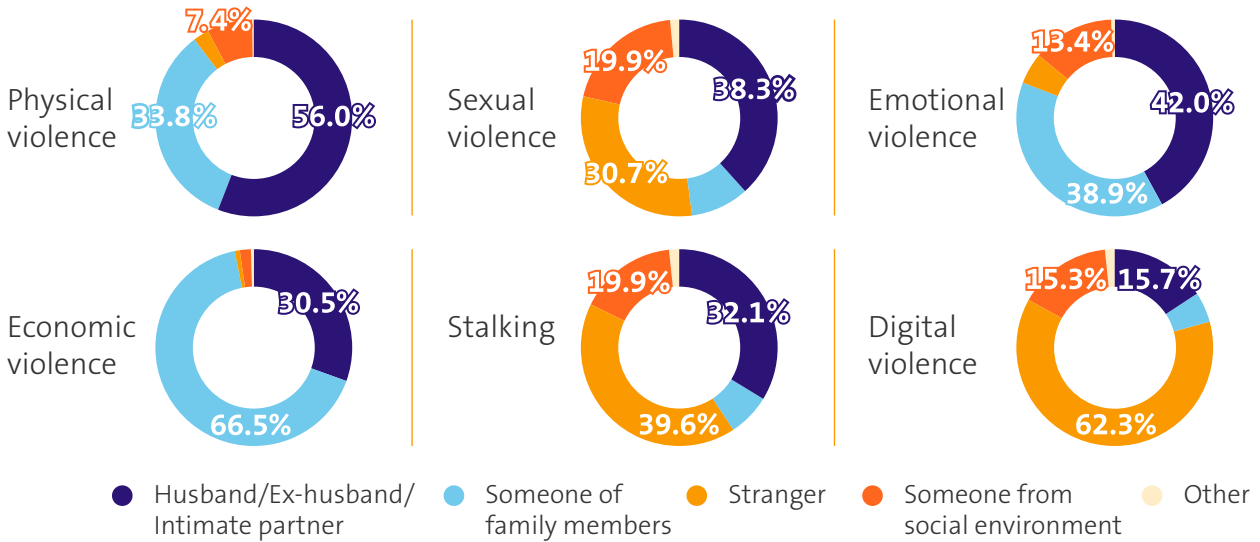

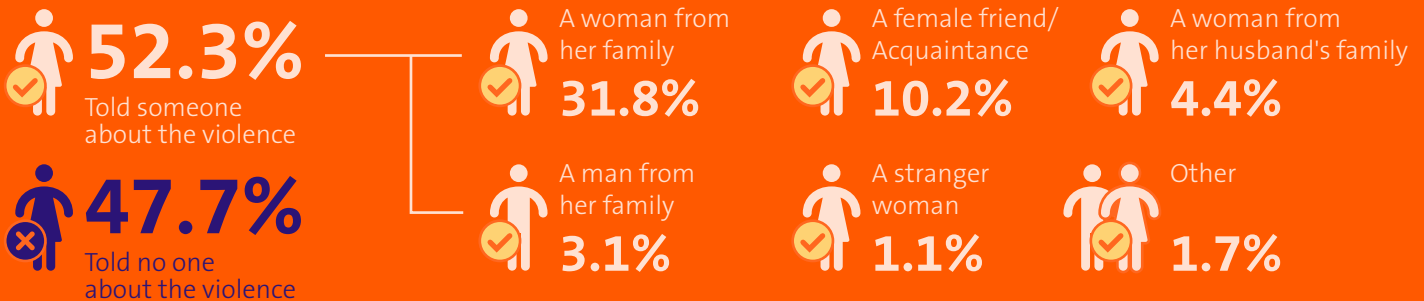

Poverty

Definitions

60% of the median income: It is defined as 60% of equivalised household disposable median income.

Equivalised household disposable income: Equivalised individual income to the specific household in other words, equivalised household disposable income, can be calculated total of household income divided by equivalised household size. This indicator has been calculated for individuals aged 15 and over.

Poverty rate: It is defined as the proportion of the poor within the total population. This indicator has been calculated for individuals aged 15 and over.

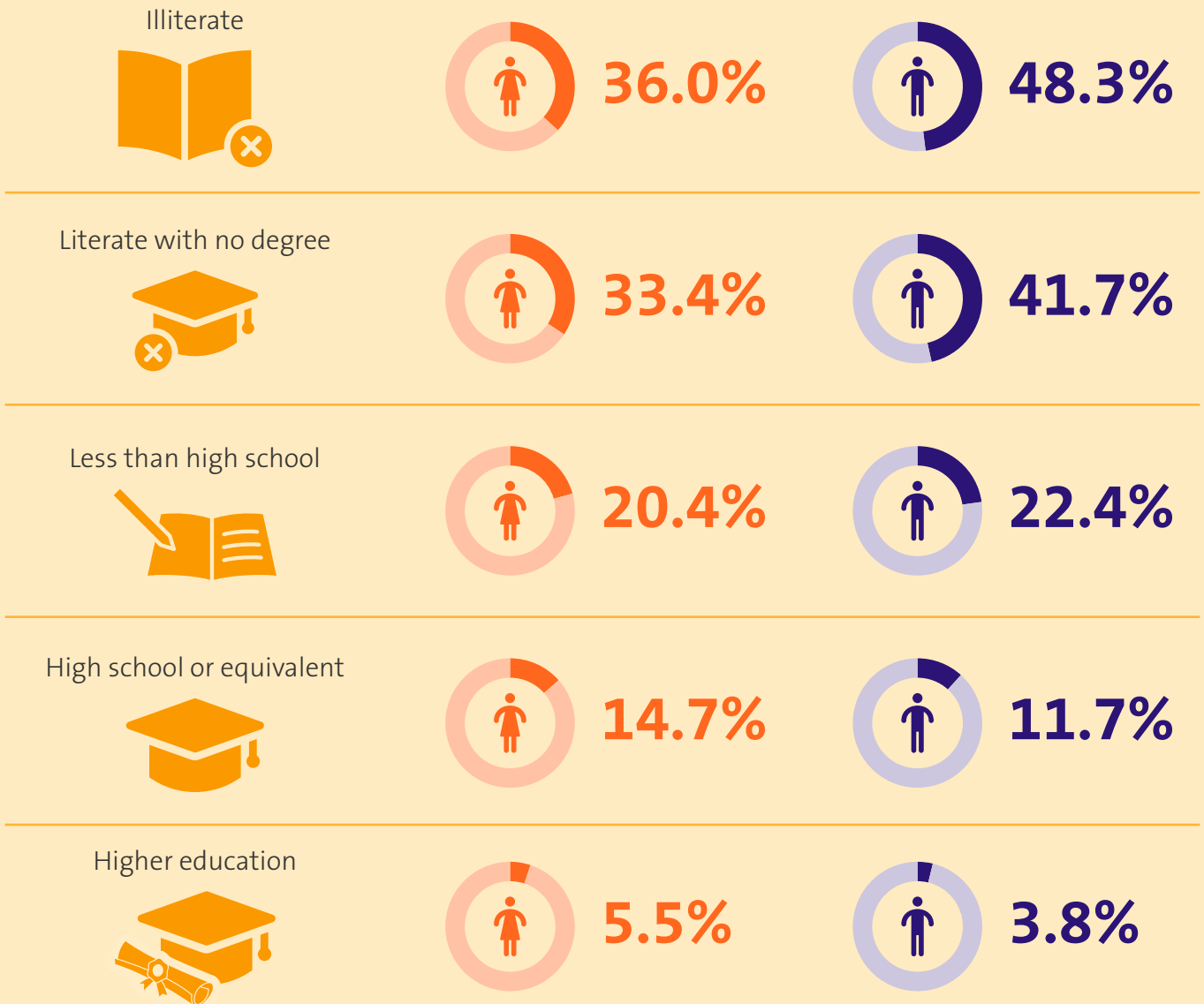

Elderly Population

Definitions

Labour force participation rate of the elderly population: Indicates the labour force participation rate among those aged 65 and over.

Literacy status of the elderly population: Indicates the literacy rate among those aged 65 and over, and the distribution of this rate by sex.

Poverty rate of the elderly population: Indicates the poverty rate among those aged 65 and over.

Proportion of the elderly population: Indicates the proportion of those aged 65 and over within the total population, and the distribution of this proportion by sex.

Proportion of the elderly population living in one-person households: Among households with members aged 65 and over, indicates the proportion of those aged 65 and over who live in single-person households, as well as the distribution of this proportion by sex.

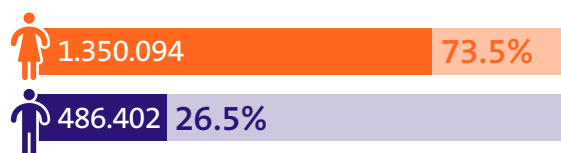
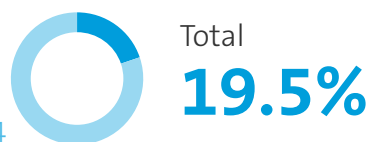
PROPORTION OF THE ELDERLY POPULATION

by gender (65+), 2025

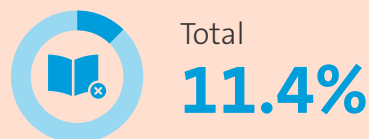

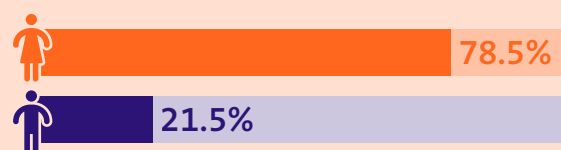
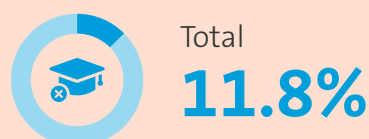

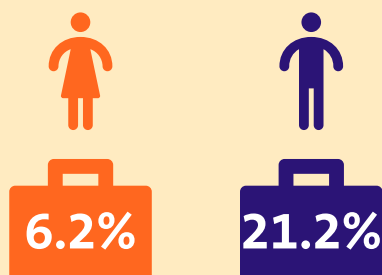

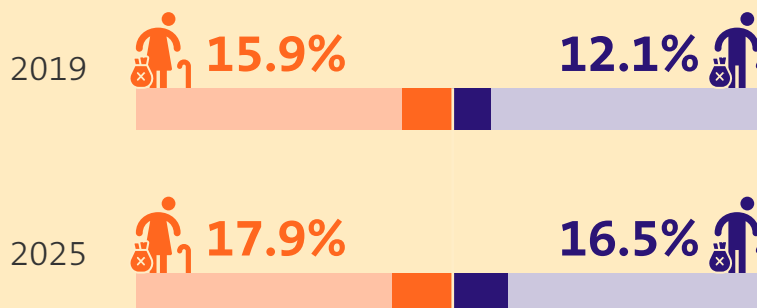

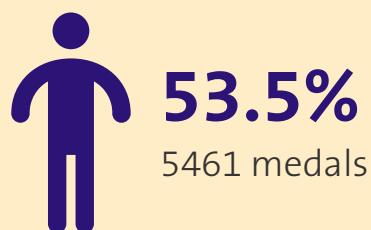
